Ways to Wed

Civil Marriage

The San Francisco County Clerk conducts civil marriages and domestic partnership ceremonies at City Hall Monday to Friday from 9 am - 3:30 pm.

Couples can have up to 6 guests attend, including kids and photographers. The locations include the rotunda or a private marriage room. Couples do **NOT** need to hire an officiant. For more info, including scheduling, refer to the <u>Clerk's website</u>.

"Walk In" Ceremony

Just trying to elope? A concise exchange of vows and signing the marriage license? Only a handful (5 or less) of guests? Consider what I lovingly call a "guerilla" ceremony. We choose a date and time, arrive at City Hall, and find a nice location (inside or outside) that isn't too busy at that time where you can exchange vows. City Hall is filled with couples taking photos and other reservation-less wedding activities.

Though slightly unorthodox, this is a great no-fuss option.



Ways to Wed

1 Hour Wedding

Book a "1 hour wedding" Monday to Friday from 9 am - 3 pm. City Hall events offers to spaces for reservation and your exclusive use: The Mayor's Balcony or the 4th Floor North Gallery. Both locations offer privacy and you can add chairs for your guests. For \$1000, you can have up to 100 guests attend. Check the availability calendar online to find your date!

Couples need to hire their own officiant.

Two Hour Wedding

Also managed by <u>City Hall Events</u>, two-hour weddings occur on Saturdays as early as 9 am with the last ceremony beginning at noon. For \$5,000 you can accommodate up to 200 guests, have more privacy (City Hall is not open to the public on weekends), and be wed beneath the dome!

Evening Weddings

City Hall is available for full evening weddings on weekdays and weekends. Check City Hall Events for more details and rental rates.

Getting Legally Wed

Marriage License

To be legally married, couples must do the following:

First: Obtain a valid marriage license from a County Clerk in the State of California. This can be issued by the San Francisco County Clerk or another County Clerk in the state. To obtain a marriage license, book an appointment in San Francisco here.


You will have the option of choosing a confidential or a public marriage license. Most couples served by Officially Hitched choose public marriage licenses. Please consult the Clerk and/or an attorney for any advice on deciding which is best for you.

This is also when you will decide if you would like to change your name. Your "new name" (such as new last name or new middle name) will be included on your marriage license. Either or both partners may elect to change their names.

Both parties to the marriage will sign the marriage license that day. You will leave the appointment with your license.

Bring the license to your wedding ceremony.





Getting Legally Wed

Wedding Officiant

Second: Select an authorized person to conduct your wedding ceremony. Your ceremony must include a verbal agreement to enter into marriage together in the presence of your witness. Any other rituals are at your discretion. Collaborate with your officiant to select the right mix of activities, rituals, and sections to include in your ceremony.

Ordained as a minister of American Marriage Ministries, Rachael Tanner is legally able to perform weddings throughout the State of California.

Solemnize the Marriage

Third: Solemnize the marriage. This occurs when the officiant oversees the signing of the license by a witness of your choosing.

If you have a public marriage license, you need at least one witness. You are allowed up to two. In addition, your officiant will sign the license.

For a confidential license, no witness is required. Only the officiant signs the marriage license.

Getting Legally Wed

Return the License

After the Ceremony, your officiant will take custody of the marriage license and return it to the appropriate county authority. The license must be returned to the County which issued the license.

If a couple obtains a public marriage license from the San Francisco County Clerk, your officiant will return it to the San Francisco County Assessor-Recorder. If your wedding is at City Hall, Rachael will return the license immediately following the ceremony. For weekend or evening weddings, the license will be returned the next business day.

Confidential marriage licenses obtained in San Francisco, will be returned to the County Clerk.

Licenses issued by other California Counties can be solemnized in any location at any wedding in any county in California. The officiant will take custody of the license and return it via certified mail to the County Clerk (or other named responsible public agency) following the ceremony.

Certified Copies

A certified copy of your marriage license will NOT be sent to you. You must request and pay for certified copies.

Consider obtaining multiple copies (3 to 4) so that you can send them out as needed to other agencies when needing to prove you are married.
